

Brandywine Discovery Days

Field Trips at Brandywine Battlefield Park designed especially for homeschool co-ops and small school groups. Learn about the Battle of Brandywine, its effect on local Quakers, and new historical skills through our rotating, hands-on stations. The changing Discovery Day themes include Be an Apprentice, Textiles, Nature and STEM, Brave the Battle, Who is an Artist?, and Think like a Historian.

Participating groups must have between 8 and 40 students in attendance. Groups of 15 or more students will be split into smaller groups of about 8-12 students plus chaperones to visit the history stations. Multiple schools/co-ops are scheduled on the same date at different time slots, ensuring each group has the opportunity to participate in as many hands-on stations as they would like.

Recommended for grades 3-7, though all grades are welcome and will have a valuable experience.

Students age 6+ and chaperones/parents: \$8 per person

Children ages 3-5: \$4 per person

Younger siblings 0-2: Free

Teachers/employees of the school: Free

-When registering, please designate which time slot you would prefer for your group to attend the history stations. When your registration is confirmed, you will be told which time slot you are assigned based on space and availability.

-Brandywine Discovery Days will go on rain or shine. The history stations are subject to change to accommodate the weather and our volunteers.

-Parking is free for both buses and cars.

-Visitors are welcome to enjoy lunch in our picnic table area from 11:40-12:20, before or after their time slot.
